Petersen Tries Pork Chop Again

Wiley Petersen, Team ASE cowboy, 25, Pocatello, ID, bulls: Pork Chop, “I was on him in Fresno in January,” said Petersen. “He didn’t have a very good trip with me...he shot out of the chute, tried to rub me off on the fence and then went right. I’m planning on a better trip this time around. Cody Lambert (PBR Stock Director) wouldn’t have brought him back if he didn’t think that he was a good bull, so I’ll just plan on him being the first-round winner.”

Pork Chop...has been to four BFTS events and has never been ridden. He has a bull rating of 38.9 out of a possible 50 points.

Petersen on Reno... “The first time I qualified for a PBR cup event was in Reno, so it will always be a good bull riding in my memory,” said Petersen. “My job this weekend is to ride four bulls. Then my goal is to get a couple of Mossy Oaks under my belt, have fun, Glorify God and make things happen.”
