## **Petersen Got Woodie**

**Wiley Petersen, Team ASE cowboy, 25, Pocatello, ID, bull: Woodie, “My bull doesn’t seem too impressive. But, I’ll have to go at him like he’s one of the rank ones, though, because he may very well be and just had a bad trip the last time he bucked,” said Petersen. “It really doesn’t matter because I’ve still got to ride him...so it’s jump for jump, kick loose and ride.”**

Woodie...has been to one BFTS events and was ridden for an average score of 82.3 points and has a bull rating of 40.5 out of a possible 50 points.

Petersen on Tacoma... *“I feel good, Amy (Petersen’s wife) gets to come and I always like west coast bull ridings,” said Petersen. “They just feel more like home. Oberto is the title sponsor and they’re really good to us. They give us jerky at each event and sometimes that’s the only thing there is to eat after we get out of the coliseums. I’m ready to win this one (Lord willing, of course).”*

## Henricks' in Bad Company

**Dan Henricks, Herculiner Truck Liner cowboy**, 25, Woodward, OK, bull: Bad Company, *"Bad Company's stats are almost exactly like my first bull in Kansas City and I faired pretty well on him," said Henricks. "He's a great draw for the first round."*

Bad Company...has been to two PBR events and has been ridden both times with an average score of 87.1 points. He has a bull score of 43.3 out of a possible 50 points.

Henricks on Tacoma...*"It wasn't a very good event for me last year. I rode both my bulls right to the whistle but didn't get the job done," said Henricks. "This go-round should be better."*

## Geleynse in Canada

**Reuben Geleynse, Team, ASE cowboy,** Winchester, Ont. Canada, will be concentrating his bull riding efforts in Canada this year. The PBR has organizations in four countries: Mexico, Australia, Brazil and Canada. Those countries will be sanctioning their own events and the monies and points the riders earn will count towards the World Championships in Las Vegas. Canada has 29 events scheduled so far this year.

*“My next events will probably be the PBR in Prince Albert, SK and then in Thorhild, AB the next day. Until then, I’ll be working, working out, practicing on my mighty bucky and enjoying the spring-like weather,” said Geleynse. “I met with a film producer in Calgary while we were there and she’s planning a documentary about rodeo life that they hope to film this summer. The director is Oscar-nominated Andrew Celinski and they plan to start shooting in June. They have asked Karina (my wife) and me to be part of it because they want to feature the lifestyle of a Christian rodeo family. They will be filming me during competition and will be observing our life both on the road and at home. They hope to have the theatrical release in early 2007. By the way, Karina is expecting in October...pretty exciting, huh!”*
