Petersen's Currently Splitting Second & Third in the Average

Wiley Petersen, Team ASE cowboy, 25, Pocatello, ID, bull: Paleface, "He'll be a challenging bull to ride," said Petersen. "But, as I always say, I just have to take it one

jump and one bull at a time and, hopefully, win the finals...that's the plan."

Paleface...has been to 18 BFTS events and has been ridden three times.

Petersen on W/C... *"I'm healthy and feel really good," said Petersen. "Praise God I'm having fun and enjoy being at the finals. I just want to be a good witness and do my best, there's no reason why I can't do that...so here we go with five more to ride."*

NOTE:

Petersen has ridden 66.67% of his last 15 bulls and he is currently tied for second with two-time World Champion Adriano Moraes in the event standings.

Henricks Draws George's Pride

Dan Henricks, Herculiner Truck Liner cowboy, 25, Woodward, OK, bull: George's Pride, *"Last weekend he spun right in the gate and then left and bucked Jared Farley off. I've seen him spin left out of the gate, too, so you can't predict. A guy's got to hustle him to get by. But, I'm really glad to draw him because he's a good one to have in this rank pen of bulls."* said Henricks.

Willingham's Currently Third in the World Standings

Sean Willingham, Team ASE/Herculiner helmet cowboy, goes up against *Scene of the Crash* who has an intimidating average back-off time of 3.78 seconds (he has only been ridden three times in 39 career attempts). Data from probullstats.com reflects an 89% buck off rate against right-handed riders, which is Willingham's preferred grip.

Condra Faces Sports Machine

Some of the most sensational names in the bucking bull industry will challenge the top 45 on Thursday evening with **Robey Condra** facing *Sports Machine* with a 46.25 judges' score out of a possible 50 points.
